that has existed at this location since 1960, as well as a departure of 18 parking spaces, located

on an irregularly shaped lot on the north side of University Boulevard, 375 feet west of 24th

Avenue, also known as 2306 University Boulevard, is:

AFFIRMED, as the basis for this action, the District Council adopts the findings and conclusions stated by the Planning Board in its Resolution, PGCPB No. 12–32, as its findings

and conclusions in this case.

In order to protect adjacent properties and the surrounding neighborhood, affirmance is

also subject to the following additional condition by the District Council.

The applicant shall explore the feasibility of increasing the width of the proposed sidewalk located along its University Boulevard frontage. If increasing the width of the proposed sidewalk is feasible, the applicant shall revise the site plan accordingly. The applicant shall not be required to increase the width of the proposed sidewalk if the increase requires additional approvals from Prince George's County or the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, or if the proposed increase is not authorized by the State Highway Administration.
