<u>RESOLUTION</u>

WHEREAS, Oaklands, LLC and M-NCPPC are the owners of a 49-acre parcel of land shown on preliminary plan 4-03133, being in the 10th Election District of Prince George's County, Maryland, and being zoned R-R; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2006, Oaklands, LLC filed an application for approval of Cluster Final Plat(s) of Subdivision known as Oaklands, Plats 1 through 4; and

WHEREAS, the application for approval of the aforesaid Final Plat(s) of Subdivision, in conformance with Preliminary Plan 4-03133 for Oaklands Cluster was presented to the Prince George's County Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission by the staff of the Commission on September 14, 2006, for its review and action in accordance with Article 28, Section 7-116, Annotated Code of Maryland and the Regulations for the Subdivision of Land, Subtitle 24, Prince George's County Code; and

WHEREAS, the staff of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission recommended APPROVAL of the application; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2006, the Prince George's County Planning Board reviewed the aforesaid application for conformance with the preliminary plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of Subtitle 24, Prince George's County Code, the Prince George's County Planning Board APPROVED Final Plats of Subdivision 5-06230 through 5-06233, pursuant to the conditions of preliminary plan 4-03133.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the findings and reasons for the decision of the Prince George's County Planning Board are as follows:

- 1. The subdivision, as modified, meets the legal requirements of Subtitles 24 and 27 of the Prince George's County Code and of Article 28, Annotated Code of Maryland.
- 2. The property is located on the north side of Contee Road, east of Baltimore Avenue (US Rt. 1).
- 3. The final plat(s) of subdivision are in conformance with preliminary plan 4-03133, Prince George's County Planning Board Resolution No. 04-52.
- 4. The final plat(s) of subdivision are in conformance with detailed site plan DSP-04032, Prince George's County Planning Board Resolution No. 05-72.
