CLASS TITLE: RECREATION CLASS INSTRUCTOR VI, GRADE N15

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CLASS:

Under direction performs class instruction, coordination, and supervision duties in highly specialized fields at an advance level for recreation classes.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

Instructs class participants in all aspects of specialized field; coordinates recitals or demonstrations as necessary; registers class participants as directed by supervisory personnel; certifies class participants where applicable; supervises Assistant Recreation Class Instructors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Eight years of paid professional experience and specialized education and training in specialized field or college graduate with five years of teaching experience in specific skills area with two years of paid professional experience; applicant must possess appropriate certifications when applicable to position vacancy.

NOTE: This classification can be filled only with adequate justification and approval of Supervisor, Coordinator, and Department Head.
